-Look at what schools need and get feedback from leadership there.

-Patty discussed addition of more social events to bring our membership together.

-Consider bringing back Sharing our Hearts event for Wine Country Fire Relief.

-Let's better understand how our affected Alliance family children are doing to address support

At Wednesday's meeting, I would like each of you to bring one idea for either a social event or for a way to support our displaced physicians. Feel free to submit them ahead of time to me or Ann Hurd. We'll have an easel to brainstorm.

Here are my ideas:

For Displaced Physicians:

Everyone lost their cookbooks and recipes — the really good ones with notes in the margins. I propose that we gather recipes from members and publish them in a recipe book for all displaced physician families. It would be self-published, have all our Alliance info in it, and be free to everyone. Cost would be printing and mailing to known displaced physician families. Should we also create a library of gently-used cookbooks?

For Alliance Membership:

Whether we share our hearts in February or have a nice romantic event for couples, I'd like to do something a little classy in February. Cocktails and live music? Maybe we tie it in with some casual fundraising. I propose a couples' event and charge nominal fee for it. Partner with SCMA?
